Every 25-30 mins Mon-Sat, 30 mins on Sun.

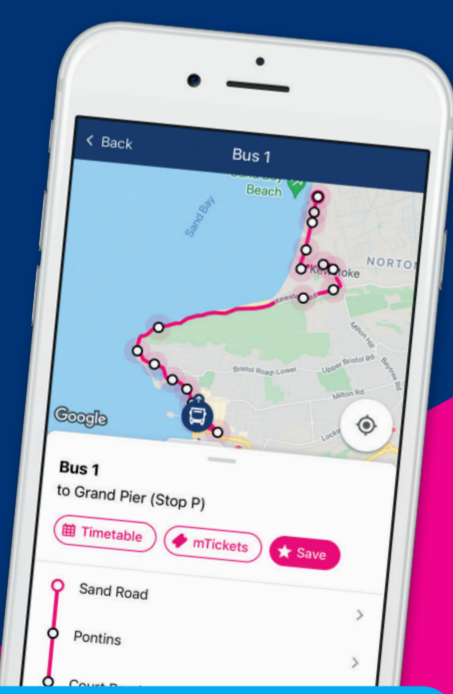
**Journey time from Weston**

**When do the buses run?**  
Every 30 mins Mon-Sat (8am to 6pm), 60 mins on Sun (9am-6pm).

**Journey time from Weston**  
30 mins to Brean, 40 mins to Burnham, 50 mins to Burnham.

This route also stops near many of the holiday parks. A picturesque route along the coast visiting beautiful beaches at Brean and Burnham-on-Sea, plus Brean with its huge expanse of sand, leisure park and the National Trust's Brean Down.

**1** Westonsuper-Mare to Birnbeck Pier & Sand Bay  
coaster

**When do the buses run?**  
Every 30 minutes 7 days a week!

**Journey time from Weston**  
18 mins to Sand Bay, 28 mins from the train station to Sand Bay.

Jump on an open top bus for amazing views on a trip along the coast. Hop off at Sand Bay and take a walk along the large and relatively wild beach before returning to all that Westonsuper-Mare has to offer.

## Grand Pier

## Uphill Nature Reserve

An action-packed indoor climbing centre for the whole family. Feeling brave? Take on the Leap of Faith and Vertical Drop Slide!

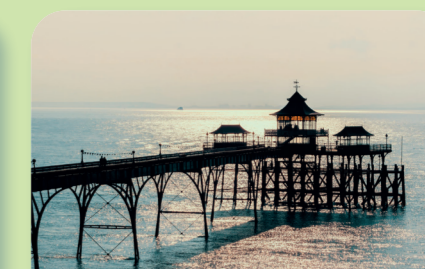

## Clevedon Marine Lake

## Clevedon Pier & Heritage Centre

## Black Nore Lighthouse

Located on the coastal path, the now decommissioned, Black Nore Lighthouse was built in 1894. It was needed to guide vessels into the River Avon to Bristol from the Severn Estuary.

## Visit amazing beaches...

### Weston-super-Mare

The main beach area lies south of The Grand Pier and during the summer season visitors flock here to sunbathe, build sandcastles and partake in all the traditional Great British seaside activities. The Uphill Sands section of the beach is partitioned off for kitesurfing and other watersports.



### Brean

The 7-mile stretch of sand and dunes that make up Brean beach lies just over two miles down the coast from Weston-super-Mare. It boasts one of the longest stretches of sand in Europe and at low tide a vast expanse of mud flats are exposed. The beach is popular with walkers, dog walkers and beach sport enthusiasts (both on and off the water).



### Burnham-on-Sea

One of Somerset's classic seaside resorts due to the exceptional stretch of beach. It's lively enough in the summer and retains much of its traditional charms - right down to donkey rides on the beach. It is also home to Britain's shortest pier, built in 1911 it's just over 100 ft long!



### Portishead

Enjoy lovely views of the South Wales coast and a walk along the coastal path from Portishead Beach all the way up to Battery Point Lighthouse.
